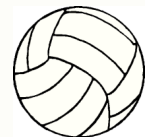

## THANK YOU

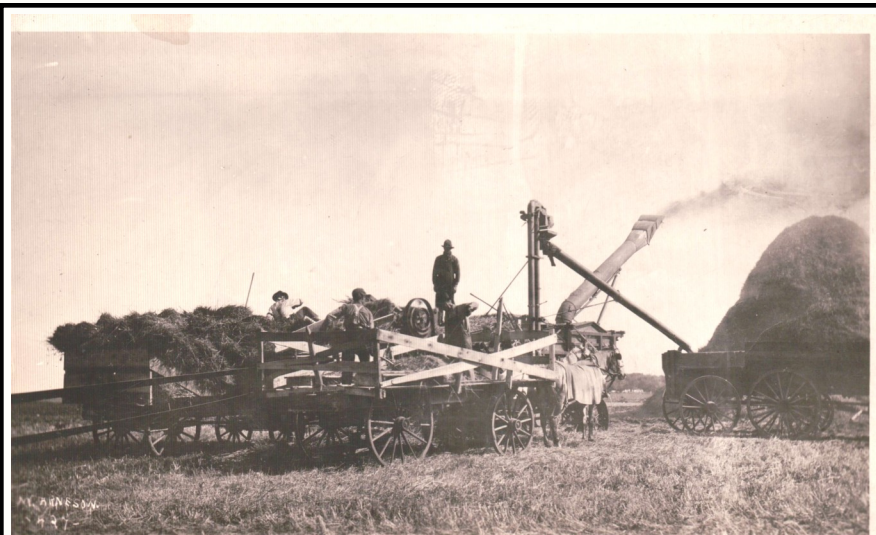
