**On Election Day, bring your Voter Information Card!  
It will make voting much quicker & easier!**

New to the 2011 Provincial General Election, **ALL VOTERS**, whether their name is on the Voters' List or not, will be required to show acceptable proof of identification and place of ordinary residence.

Voters have 3 options for proving their identification and place of residence:

1. Show one original piece of identification with their photo, name and address. It must be issued by a government agency.

Example: Driver's licence

**OR**

2. Show 2 valid original documents. Both pieces must have your name and one must also have your address.

Example: Health card and utility bill

**OR**

3. Swear an oath and have an eligible voter vouch for your identity and place of ordinary residence. The person vouching for you must have valid authorized identification (*both of you will be required to make a sworn statement*). This person can only vouch for one person.

Please do not assume that because you personally know the workers at your polling station that they can just waive off these rules and let you vote. They must follow the rules of the election. In fact, they will even be asking their own spouses for proper identification!

**Noxious & Field Weeds:** The Council of the RM of Reno has received a request to address the issue of noxious and field weeds. There are a number of avenues available should any person require assistance in combating the problem. The local weed inspector, Elmer Palmer, and Dale Risula from the Agriculture Knowledge Center are free for consultation regarding this issue and would be willing to meet with you at a time that is convenient for you. The toll free number for the Agriculture Knowledge Center is 1-866-457-2377.

**Bale Stacks:** It has come to Council's attention that there are numerous bale stacks placed too close to the road. In accordance to bylaw 125/70 Council has asked that they be placed 150 feet from the center of the road or 300 feet from an intersection. Anyone in contravention of this bylaw is subject to our penalty bylaw 206/07 and may incur a fine up to \$10,000. The RM appreciates your attention to this matter as it will help with keeping snow accumulation at a minimum.
