PROVINCIAL ELECTION RESULTS

The Cypress Hills constituency re-elected Wayne Elhard as its representative in Regina. Locally the two polls in Consul supported that decision.

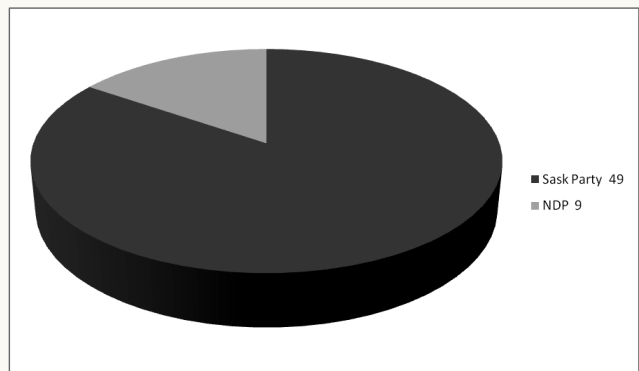


In Poll 50, Village of Consul and North of Consul, the results were 100 votes for the Saskatchewan Party, 7 votes for the Green Party, and 5 votes for the New Democratic Party (no rejected ballots). 112 of a possible 185 people voted for a turnout of 60.5%.

Poll 51, South of Consul, showed 65 votes for the Saskatchewan Party, 7 votes for the Green Party, and 2 votes for the NDP (1 ballot was rejected). This poll had 139 voters on the list, and 75 of those came to vote for a 54% turnout.

Provincially, Brad Wall and the Sask. Party were solidly returned to govern the province, winning 49 of a possible 58 seats. The other 9 were won by the NDP. Going into the election, the Sask. Party held 38 seats to the NDP's 20. A resounding 64% of the popular vote went to the Sask. Party which broke a 99-year record set by the Liberals in 1912 when they won with just under 57% of the vote.

Voter turnout was down across the province this time compared to four years ago. In 2007, 76% of voters cast ballots compared to 66% this time around. In comparison, though, Manitoba's recent turnout of 57.6% and Ontario's record-low turnout of 49.2% makes Saskatchewan's turnout look good. Plus with the other two provincial elections having been held in early October, voters were not likely battling icy roads to get to the polls like some Saskatchewan voters were on Monday.
