Stop by the library this summer & check out our shelves too.

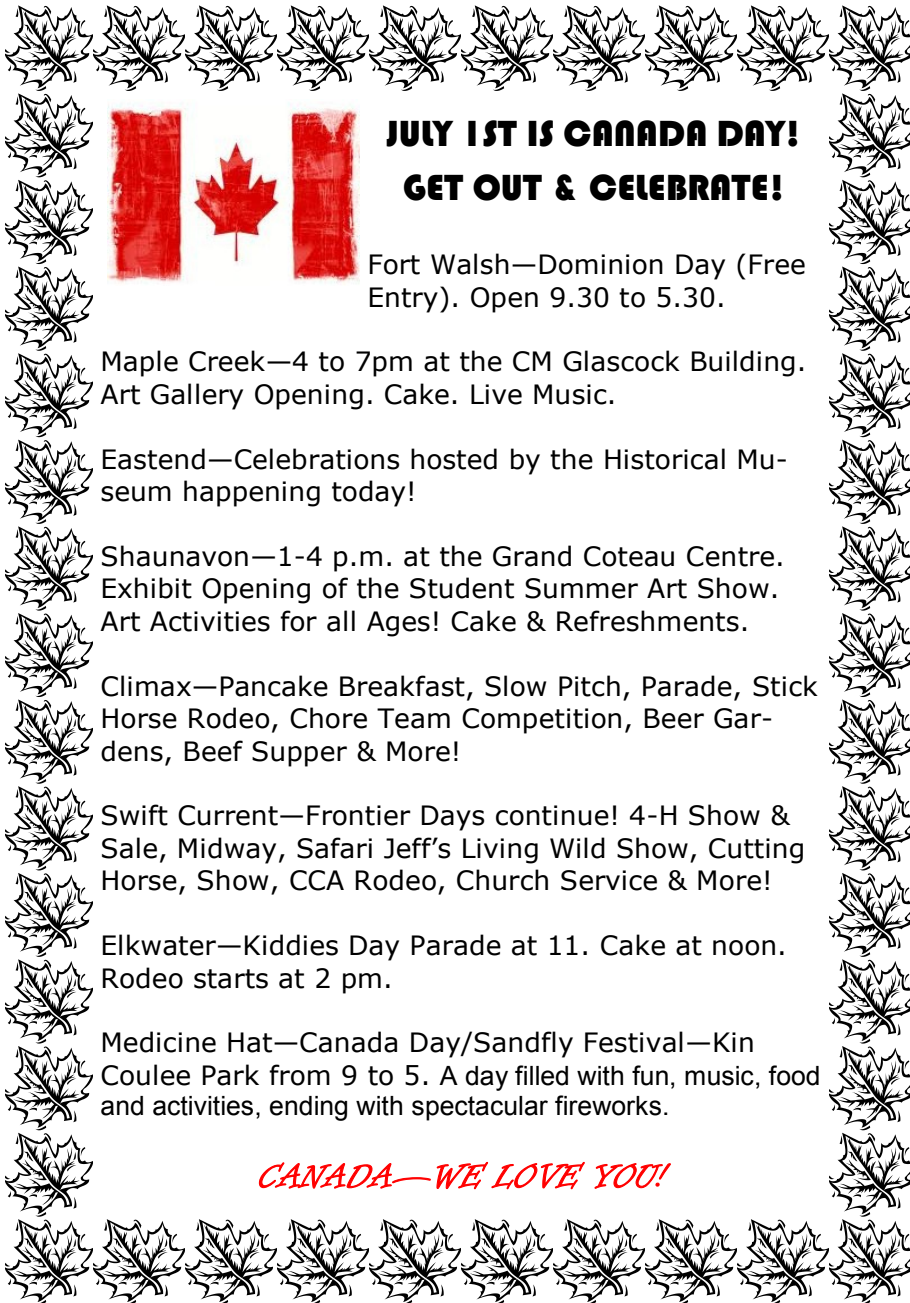
