

The purpose of the South West Mini Circuit (SWMC) is the bringing together of local riding club horse shows, and local agriculture societies and sports associations in support of producing a group of horse shows that are similar in classes, rules and quality. We are encouraging the local rider to attend more than their home town horse show, to give them the confidence to go beyond the local show ring. We want the rider to learn from the experience of horse showing. Points are collected by the horse and rider combination, and are credited to the age division of the rider. Junior horse is a horse that as of January 1st is under 5 years old. A halter horse is one that collects points on build of the horse, either for a breed or open to all breeds. Western Division includes classes such as: western pleasure, western riding, reining and trail. English Horse Division - English pleasure, road hack, show hack, hunter, jumper. Speed Horse Division - barrel racing, pole bending, stake race, key hole race. Age categories for the rider are: as of January 1st - Senior is 18 and older, Junior A is 15 years to 17 years, Junior B is 12 years to 14 years, Junior C is 9 years to 11 years, Pee Wees are 8 years and under.
