CONSUL ROCKETS


The Rockets held their **Annual Shoot-out** on Friday, February 22nd. The following are the results:

LOCAL CHURCHES BUSY WITH MISSION WORK

The Consul Church of God and St. Stephen's Catholic Church have been working this month to support mission projects that are near and dear to their hearts.

Actually, people may not realize it, but months of preparation and fundraising precede the Mission Team's journey to Mexico. It all comes together and the fruits of their labour are realized when hugs are received from grateful new homeowners. The group left mid-February and are due to arrive home today. Kathy Smith sent this report back for us:

"The house build in Mexico is completed. Twenty-seven people from Medicine Hat to Maple Creek to Manitoba to Consul travelled to Mexico to do a house build for a needy family. We built a 32 x 20 house with three bedrooms and kitchen/living room all in one. The family we built for was an incredibly gracious and loving family—Omero and Mari and their three children. Mari, the mother, is in a wheelchair."

Kathy says to watch for further information about a date and time when they will be sharing a presentation about the trip.

Since 2006, St. Stephen's Parish has been reaching out to some of the least fortunate in Togo, Africa. In an area where the number of people with HIV and AIDS is twice the national average. there exists the Loyola Hope Centre, built by Canadian Jesuits International. The staff there strive to provide care, support, education...and hope...to those affected. As a fundraiser for the mission this year, the idea of a benefit concert was suggested and pursued by the local group.

Thus, on the evening of February 25th, eighty people enjoyed an entertaining evening of country music and cowboy poetry in the Consul Hall. Ken Overcast put on a wonderful show, accompanied by two very talented individuals—his lovely nine-year-old granddaughter, Molly Halingstad, who sang and played along on her fiddle, and Cory Miller, whose guitar talent added an extra dimension to every number. With the generous support of the people who attended plus others who donated even if they could not be there, we are pleased that we will be able to send the Hope Centre double the amount that we have in past years!
