This April, celebrate Earth Month with us!

We can all do our part to make the Earth a better place to live. It's the little things we do every day and turn into habits that really add up. Like, have you made recycling a part of your routine? These are all things that can be taken to SARCAN in Maple Creek or other recycling centres, so that they stay out of the garbage and out of landfills:

- ◆ home and car stereos, radios, speakers, turntables, VCRs, DVD players, PVRs, projectors, cable and satellite receivers and digital cameras;
- ◆ deposit beverage containers;
- ◆ cardboard (all boxes plus tubes from toilet paper and paper towels), paper, magazines, catalogues, paperback books, labels from tin cans;
- ◆ plastic containers (ones with the recycling symbol on the bottom), plastic bags, milk jugs and cartons, tin cans, glass jars and bottles;
- ◆ non-contaminated used oil, filters and original oil containers;
- ◆ paint and stain.

More businesses are helping us be eco-friendly.

- ◆ Both London Drugs and Staples have drop-offs for used alkaline and rechargeable batteries, ink and toner cartridges. Also CFL bulbs, and small appliances and their packaging (if purchased there) at London Drugs;
- ◆ Places such as Battery Direct in Medicine Hat will give your money for your used automotive batteries.

These are other items that fall into the category of "one man's garbage is another man's treasure":

- ◆ Campbell's soup labels, Prego Sauce lids and more are collected by Reno Rascals Childcare for "Labels for Education" program (see [labelsforeducation.ca](http://labelsforeducation.ca));
- ◆ donations of old jewelry, popsicle sticks, stiff paper towel rolls and other crafting supplies would be put to use by the Reno Rascal kids;
- ◆ pop can tabs support Ronald McDonald House in Calgary. Drop them off with Ira Blakley who will pass them along;
- ◆ cancelled postage stamps (with 1/4" border left around them) are collected by St. Stephen's CWL to support missions;
- ◆ shoes and coats in good shape are collected by the Mexico Mission Team;

- ◆ gently used clothing and household items can be donated to Salvation Army or Value Village locations;
- ◆ extra yarn can be knit or crocheted into squares to help the homeless—see [blankets4canada.ca](http://blankets4canada.ca);
- ◆ old phone books can be dropped off at Consul School (SaskTel's program gives them 10 cents per book).
- ◆ used eyeglasses are accepted at many optometrists' offices and eyeglass stores to be donated to third world countries;
- ◆ building materials and supplies, new and used, can be taken to the Re-Store in Medicine Hat. They sell them to raise money for Habitat for Humanity.

We can all reduce waste by practicing composting as well. Our fruit and vegetable scraps can easily be turned back into valuable nutrients for the soil. There are many good online articles on this topic. Simply type "how to compost" into an online search engine.

As you can see, there are all kinds of things that can be diverted from the garbage. Hope we have helped make your next bag of trash a little lighter!
