1. 1966—The Roughriders defeated Ottawa 29-14 to win the 1966 Grey Cup.
2. Eagle Keys
3. George Reed
4. Dave Ridgway kicked the winning field goal in the 1989 Grey Cup with two seconds remaining, giving Saskatchewan a 43-40 victory over Hamilton.
5. Kent Austin was named the most outstanding offensive player in the 1989 Grey Cup after throwing for 474 yards and three touchdowns. He was the Riders' head coach when they won the Grey Cup in 2007, and he is now the head coach of the Hamilton Tigercats.
6. Ray Elgaard was named the CFL's most outstanding Canadian three times – in 1988, 1990 and 1992. Andy Fantuz got the award in 2010.
7. Roger Aldag was named the CFL's most outstanding offensive lineman in 1986 and 1988. Greene—2003. Makowsky—2004 and 2005.

9. 1977. The name Gainer is an anagram of Regina.
10. The team was founded as the Regina Rugby Club in 1910.
