**CORRECTION:** In regards to the trivia that was in the last issue, it was brought to my attention that the first store that David Johnson moved to Consul was **not** moved from Vidora. It was actually moved from the pre-emption that belonged to David's brother, Neil Johnson. Neil had a homestead and pre-emption on the N1/2 19-4-26W3 (which is just east of Consul).

For those of you who are like me and had not heard of a pre-emption before, here is a little history lesson on that. Pre-emptions were introduced by the Canadian government in 1874 and allowed a homesteader to obtain a second quarter section of land adjacent to the homestead. Patent (or ownership papers) for the pre-emption could be obtained when a fixed price for the land had been paid by installments over eight years. As well, an additional fifty acres of land were required to be cultivated (over and above the homestead requirement) to be eligible for the pre-emption.

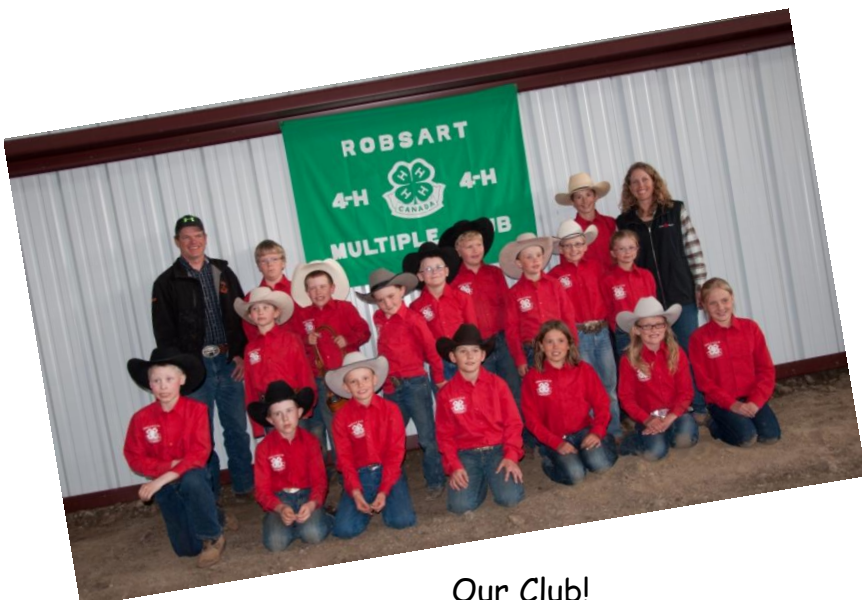
