- 44% of all farmland in Canada is in Saskatchewan.

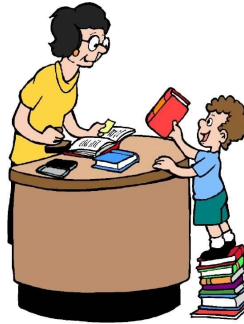
