UPDATE FROM LIVING HOPE RANCH

Throughout the last month we (LHR Board) have processed, and pondered deeply our desire to open a home for teen girls in our community. Since our community information presentation and discussions, we have had numerous encouraging conversations and inquiries, including requests for applications, partnerships and donations. Through our discussions we have come to the following conclusions:

- Consul is an ideal community for such a venture. It offers a valuable resource of many caring and skilled people who would embrace young girls who need support to find hope and healing. This resource of caring has shown itself in the past and remains powerful today.
- While our isolation does present some potential barriers to emergency and security services, we feel that it is manageable within the context of the girls we choose to help. The isolation actually becomes a very attractive component to the success of the program.
- 3. We acknowledge that there are people in the community who will never be comfortable with a home like this too close to their property, and it is not our desire to be the cause of fear for our neighbours. On the same token, it is not in the interest of LHR to place the girls within an area in which they do not feel welcomed. Many of these girls will come from places of rejection and fear, and we do not want to intensify that in their lives. Therefore, LHR will not temporarily locate where we initially intended.
- 4. We are also excited about the economic potential for our community. LHR was birthed through conversations of potential businesses which might be started within the community. This half-million dollar business has the potential to offer employment to people presently living here, and to inspire people to move here.

Therefore, we would like to invite the community to consider with us where we might be welcome to start LHR. We would need a home outside of town which

could house up to 6 people with yard space to provide care for 4-5 horses. We would consider this a temporary situation, to help us get the program operational. Basically, we are looking for a location within the RM of Reno #51 where the surrounding neighbours would come alongside as partners and accept the challenges with LHR to launch this endeavour.
