WORLD WAR II

AMUNDSON, SAM - was born in Maple Creek in 1913 and was raised on the homestead south of Robsart. He joined the Canadian Army at Calgary in the early years of the war, going overseas in 1943. He along with others were sent to reinforce the 10th Infantry Brigade of the Algonquin Regiment, 4th Canadian Armoured Division, on October 23, 1944. He was killed in action at the Hochwald Gap in Germany on March 3, 1945.

OLSON, OLE ADRIAN - was born at Robsart on April 30, 1919 and joined the Royal Canadian Navy at Esquimalt, BC in September 1938. He won his first class stokers rating in March 1939 and was on the HMCS Fraser when it was rammed and sunk off the coast of France in June 1940. Ole was rescued, along with others, under extreme difficulties as the ships were being bombed during the time of the accident. Ole went down with HMCS destroyer Margaree on October 22, 1943.

SCHMIDT, WALTER BERNHARDT - was born in 1918 to Leopold and Antonie Schmidt. He enlisted in January 1942 with the Royal Canadian Ordnance Corps and a year later went overseas where he was transferred to the Royal Canadian Electrical and Mechanical Engineers. He passed away while on leave to Belgium, March 14, 1945.

SAWDEN, CHARLES EDWARD - was born at Yorkshire, England on June 17, 1910. He enlisted with the South Saskatchewan Regiment at Weyburn on September 26, 1939. Charles was killed in action at the Dieppe Raid on August 19, 1942. Being widely and well known in the district, his death brought the war close to home, he being one of the first casualties.

ZENTNER, JACK - was born on June 12, 1924 to Mr. and Mrs. S.K. Zentner and grew up in the Senate district. In 1945, while serving with the Merchant Marines, Jack was on a Canadian tanker that was rammed by an American freighter off the coast of Massachusetts. Out of the crew of 54, only two survived and only two bodies were recovered, Jack's and another. He was buried at Bedford, MA.

WILSON, REGINALD WILLIAM - was born October 22, 1924 to Jimmy and Minnie Wilson and grew up in Govenlock. Enlisting in January 1944, Reg was unfortunately killed in a train accident in Alberta on July 18, 1944 and was buried with full military honours at the Field of Honour, Burnsland Cemetery, at Calgary.
