

The Battlefords will host Ice Hockey and Ice Curling for the Saskatchewan 55+ Provincial Games 2016.



Ice Curling is scheduled for March 15-17, 2016 at the Northland Power Curling Centre in North Battleford. Categories include Women's, Men's, and Mixed teams. Each game is 8 ends. Ice Curling follows Canadian Curling Association Rules.

Stick Curling is scheduled for March 15-17, 2016 at the Northland Power Curling Centre in North Battleford. There will be no age or gender categories. Each team consists of 2 people and may be both men, both women or one of each. Gold, silver, and bronze will be presented to the winners. No advancement to Canada Games.

Ice Hockey is scheduled for March 18-20, 2016 at the Battleford's Arena. There is a minimum of 11 players per team. Each game is two 20 minute periods. Ice Hockey follows Canadian Adult Recreation Hockey Association (CARHA) rules.

Registration fees for hockey will be \$600 per team and curling is \$140 per team (4 person). \$70.00 per team (2 person). Curling includes 3 game guarantee. Fees include banquet. Additional banquet tickets \$20.
