As of today, we are only 28 days away from the opening of the 2018 Winter Olympics in South Korea which start on February 9 and close on February 25. Barring any changes, Canada's Olympic team is comprised of 221 athletes, competing in every discipline except Nordic Combined. Can you name the other fourteen winter sports at the Olympics? The list of athletes going to South Korea from Saskatchewan is short. It includes Ben Hebert, competing in Men's Curling as lead on Kevin Koe's team, and Emily Clark who is a member of the women's ice hockey team.

Online, there are all kinds of ways to connect with all of Team Canada—Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, Olympic.ca. Even the breakfast cereal, Cheerios, has gotten on board with a postcard on their box that can be sent to the team. No postage is necessary as postage is prepaid. You can also go their website, sendyourcheer.ca, and send some online cheer.

Stay even more connected to the games by installing an app on your device. The Olympics—Official App is one and PyeongChang 2018 Official App is another. You can even turn on notifications so you are one of the first to know that Canada has won another medal! The CBC App is another good place to follow the action.

And, of course, you can watch them on tv. CBC has the broadcast rights to the games, so check for them there. Keep in mind the time difference—PyeongChang is 15 hours ahead of us.
