MLA REPORT

Enhancements Made to Crop Insurance Program Coverage for 2018

Saskatchewan producers will have access to very high coverage as the Crop Insurance Program continues to improve, as a result of the success of Saskatchewan farmers and ranchers.

There are a number of enhancements for the Crop Insurance Program in 2018, such as:

- fire insurance for pastureland,
- more crops to be insured under the Contract Price Option, and increased compensation rates for cattle lost due to predators.

The deadline for producers to apply for, renew or make changes to their Crop Insurance contract is March 31, 2018. The Saskatchewan Crop Insurance Corporation has 21 offices across the province with experts who can help producers review the range of features and options available to customize coverage to the needs of their operation.
