consul hall happenings

The Consul Hall Board would like to touch base with everyone in the community and let you know what we are up to. As many of you know, we have buckled down and tackled a couple of big improvements to our community hall in the past few years. We renovated the washrooms and had the hall's hardwood floor refinished. These were much needed and expensive undertakings, but, lots of positive feedback from hall users means it did not go unnoticed. That brings us to what needs to happen now. The hall has had an ongoing and sporadic issue with sewer smell during different functions for a long time. We have exhausted most of the "least expensive" fixes for this problem. Unfortunately the smell is still a problem. We are now looking into removing the old septic tank which is "right" next to the hall and replacing it with a new septic tank (and a submersible sewer pump) further away from the building, meeting today's recommendations. This plan is very preliminary yet as we gather information and quotes to do this. The final decision is yet to be decided if we will go ahead with this expensive improvement. This improvement when completed will be one no one will notice (and, hopefully not smell!!!). With all this said, we would like to **"Save the Date" of October 27th** evening for an exciting **fundraiser event** that the Hall Board is in the process of planning. More details will follow at a later date. In closing we would like to thank the community and everyone who continually donates and supports our hall. We feel this building is an important part of this community and thank those who are as compassionate about it as we are.
