It is an exciting time as we gear up to reopen Living Hope Ranch. The last two years have been filled with rewriting policy, program development, fundraising and staff hiring. It has been a long stretch of waiting and a test in patience. However, the phone has continued to ring with families in need, searching for a program like ours. Most of what has been happening is behind the scenes as the process of building and developing is a never-ending one. Although it is one we are grateful for as we have worked very hard to strengthen our program and get it back up and running.

As of February 1, 2019 we have 85% of our staffing needs filled and things are in full swing as the busyness continues to increase. We are getting closer and closer to our long anticipated reopening date, with a full list of clients waiting to come, and a revamped program.
