

While COVID-19 has temporarily changed what we do and how we do it, it has not changed who we are. Saskatchewan people are demonstrating strength and resilience in doing their part to flatten the curve and prevent the spread of this virus.

Saskatchewan.ca is your best resource for accurate details of the COVID-19 pandemic and government's response. You can find up-to-date information on testing, public health orders, self-isolation tips, news releases and travel information.

The Cypress Hills Constituency Office remains open to assist you with government programs and services.

Governments across Canada and around the world remain focused on COVID-19, here in Saskatchewan we have been looking at the best and safest ways to re-open and re-start our economy while protecting residents from infection. Our province has introduced a staged approach that is working well so far.

The Saskatchewan Small Business Emergency Payment has been extended to businesses who still need to remain closed or significantly curtail operations after May 19, 2020.

As part of our COVID-19 response, the Government of Saskatchewan is fast-tracking a record \$278 million in municipal revenue sharing. This stable, consistent, no strings attached funding can be invested in programs and services as communities see fit.

A new \$2 billion infrastructure stimulus is also designed to encourage local job creation and support our province's economic recovery. This includes \$150 million in a per capita payment through a new Municipal Economic Enhancement Program to support infrastructure projects across the province. This is in addition to \$5.5 billion in planned infrastructure investment to schools, hospitals, highways, municipal infrastructure, Crown utility and other important projects.

In all, this \$7.5 billion stimulus balances smaller short-term projects that can start sooner and get people back to work more quickly with larger projects that will involve several sectors. The safety of workers and communities is paramount which is why work sites will be required to follow all physical distancing measures and restrictions through all five phases of our Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan.

Increased investment in infrastructure will build a strong Saskatchewan by helping more worker get back on the job, helping more companies get back to business, and helping families and communities bounce back from the impacts of COVID-19.
