WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH October 2020



Women and Gender Equality Canada | Femmes et Égalité des genres Canada | Canada

October is Women's History Month in Canada, a time to celebrate the women and girls from our past, and our present, who are contributing to a better, more inclusive Canada.

In 1992, the Government of Canada designated October as Women's History Month, marking the beginning of an annual month-long celebration of the outstanding achievements of women and girls throughout Canada's history.

This year's theme **#BecauseOfYou**, celebrates women and girls in Canada who have made, and continue to make, a lasting impact on our country.

One notable woman from Saskatchewan is Sylvia Fedoruk (1927-2012). She was a Canadian physicist and an outstanding researcher in the field of nuclear medicine. She is remembered for helping to advance cancer diagnosis and treatment. In 1951, Fedoruk was the only woman on the team that developed the first cobalt radiation unit, now routinely used in cancer treatment. She became the first woman Chancellor of the University of Saskatchewan, the first woman trustee of the Society of Nuclear Medicine, the first woman appointed to the Atomic Energy Control Board of Canada, and the first woman to serve as Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan (1988-1994). For her efforts, she was made an Officer of the Order of Canada and received a Governor General's Award in Commemoration of the Persons Case. As well, in 2009, she was inducted into the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame.



Another interesting tidbit about Fedoruk is that she is a past president (1971 to 1972) of the Canadian Ladies Curling Association. In 1986, she was inducted into the Canadian Curling Hall of Fame, as a builder, and was awarded the Saskatchewan Order of Merit. In 1961, she played in the very first Diamond 'D' Championships for team Saskatchewan as the third for Joyce McKee. Saskatchewan won the tournament.

Three ways to vote:

1 Vote by mail.

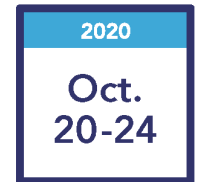
Involves marking a blank ballot and mailing it back to ESK.

- A. You need to apply first.
- B. Applications must be at Elections SK by Oct. 15, but don't wait until then.
- C. Vote by mail ballots must be placed in the mail by 8 p.m. on October 26.



2 Vote at an advance poll.

- A. 5 consecutive days, Oct. 20-24.
- B. 40 total hours of advance voting.
- C. 300+ advance poll locations across SK.
- D. Check voter information card for the advance poll we recommend to each voter. Polls are assigned to reduce wait times.
- E. Polls are open Noon to 8 p.m.



3 Vote on election day.

- A. Oct. 26
- B. Last day to vote.
- C. 1800+ polling locations across SK.
- D. Check voter information card for the specific poll.
- E. Polls are open 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.
