

WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH October 2020

October is Women's History Month in Canada, a time to celebrate the women and girls from our past, and our present, who are contributing to a better, more inclusive Canada.

In 1992, the Government of Canada designated October as Women's History Month, marking the beginning of an annual month-long celebration of the outstanding achievements of women and girls throughout Canada's history.

This year's theme **#BecauseOfYou**, celebrates women and girls in Canada who have made, and continue to make, a lasting impact on our country.

One notable woman from Saskatchewan is Sylvia Fedoruk (1927-2012). She was a Ca-



nadian physicist and an outstanding researcher in the field of nuclear medicine. She is remembered for helping to advance cancer diagnosis and treatment. In 1951, Fedoruk was the only woman on the team that developed the first cobalt radiation unit, now routinely used in cancer treatment. She became the first woman Chancellor of the University of Saskatchewan, the first woman trustee of the Society of Nuclear Medicine, the first woman appointed to the Atomic Energy Control Board of Canada, and the first woman to serve as Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan (1988-1994). For her efforts, she was made an Officer of the Order of Canada and received a Governor General's Award in Commemoration of

the Persons Case. As well, in 2009, she was inducted into the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame.

Another interesting tidbit about Fedoruk is that she is a past president (1971 to 1972) of the Canadian Ladies Curling Association. In 1986, she was inducted into the Canadian Curling Hall of Fame, as a builder, and was awarded the Saskatchewan Order of Merit. In 1961, she played in the very first Diamond 'D' Championships for team Saskatchewan as the third for Joyce McKee. Saskatchewan won the tournament.


