# VOTE 2021 - THE RESULTS FROM POLL 118 - CONSUL, SK

Pat yourselves on the back, voters of Consul and area! Once again you turned out and showed how important it is to you to exercise your right to vote. Young and old, first-time voters and veterans - you were there. If you disregard names on the voter's list of people that we knew no longer live in our area (25 names), that left a list of 299 potential voters. 212 people voted at our poll on Monday, September 20; an additional 36 voted in advance polls for a total of 248 votes cast. That is an **83%** voter turnout!! National voter turnout will not be determined until mail-in ballots are tallied. 1.2 million mail-in voting kits were requested by Canadians and the ones that got returned on time began the processing procedure on September 21.

It sure helped speed the voting along. It may have been a long day (almost 16 hours worked) but it is satisfying to know that we contributed to the democratic process as well as ensured that a poll could be located in Consul once again. We encourage more of you to become involved in working at the next election!
