Attention RM of Reno Ratepayers:

Council wishes to address this year's tax increase. Council regrets there was such an increase in taxes in one year. Looking back, they see that it would have been better to have a progression of increases over the past few years - for this they apologize.

For many years the majority of the RM's operating revenue has been generated from the Commercial Property Class. In recent years we have seen a huge amount of Oil and Gas abandonments. The loss of this revenue means the burden of the levy has shifted to the Agriculture and Residential Property Classes. This shift unfortunately raised taxes, along with the other factors that were stated in the letter enclosed with your 2021 Tax Notices.

In light of the transition of where the majority of the RM's operating revenue is now raised, Council is diligently working to find ways to lower costs and to adjust services so we will continue to meet the needs of our rate-payers while possibly reducing some of the revenue needed going forward.

Council encourages Ratepayers to have discussions with your Division Councillors to express what services are most important to you! Councillors will bring your priorities to the RM meetings to be taken into consideration in planning for the future.


